## Chipping Day is Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup> – Mark your Calendar!

Details to follow but expect little change from previous years. Once the snow melts, start by collecting any and all deadfall. As spring begins to set in, move on to pruning dead branches from smaller trees and take down any smaller dead trees if able.

Attached is a guide for selecting trees for the Front Range (typically look to more drought resistant variants for our area) as well as planting and caring tips. The folks at Heidrich's Tree Farm & Nursery are good at providing even more specifics based on our higher elevation here.
